Misunderstanding in Report in Windsor Star, May 14, 2010

Considerable controversy has resulted from the report by Dave Battagello in the Windsor Star of May 14, 2010 of points made in a news conference by Transport Action Ontario and Sierra Club, Ontario the previous day.

We wish to make the following clarification:

Transport Action Ontario neither opposes nor supports an Ambassador Bridge replacement span. That span is one of a list of alternatives to the DRIC we propose for further study. For more details, please see our *Checklist of Transportation Alternatives* on this website.

Transport Action Ontario advocates for sustainable transportation province-wide. We have addressed and will continue to address transportation-related issues in all regions of Ontario.
